Dear President Metsola, Dear Deputy Permanent Representative Cartuyvels,

On 22 June 2022, the Commission adopted a proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the sustainable use of plant protection products and amending Regulation (EU) 2021/2115¹. On 22 November 2023, the European Parliament rejected the proposal as amended in plenary and called on the Commission to withdraw its proposal². The Council continued its first reading, with divergent views expressed by the Member States.

The proposal had the worthy aim of reducing the risks of chemical plant protection products. However, it has become a symbol of polarization. It has been rejected by the European Parliament and there is no progress in the Council. While the topic remains relevant, further dialogue and a different approach is needed. Therefore, the Commission intends to withdraw the proposal by 31 March 2024.
